
PETITION TO FILE SECOND
SUPPLEMENTAL APPENDIX

Undersigned counsel requests leave in which to file a second supplemental appendix in the case. On June 30, 2014, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari, appendix, and supplemental appendix in the above titled case were filed with this Court. A supplemental appendix was necessary at that time because the memorandum in support of the application for post-conviction relief had been excluded from the appendix inadvertently. Today, counsel realized the memorandum in support of the application, which is the only document in the supplemental appendix was not complete. The memorandum is six pages long. The supplemental appendix provides only the first five pages. This was obviously an oversight by counsel.

WHEREFORE, counsel requests leave in which to file the second supplemental appendix in this case.




