ORDER

Respondent has filed a motion to amend the record on appeal to include several missing pages from the trial transcript. Specifically, Respondent requests that pages 146, 160, 161, 165, and 167 of the trial transcript be added to the record. Respondent also requests that the time to file her final brief be extended to twenty days after filing of the amended record.

Appellant has consented to Respondent's request for an extension and the addition of pages 160 and 165-67.¹ Appellant further requests that pages 142-43 of the trial transcript be added to the record.

We note that pages 142-43 and 146 of the trial transcript already appear in the record on pages 74-75 and 18, respectively. Because page 161 of the trial transcript was not included in either Appellant's or Respondent's designation of matter, Respondent's request to add this page is denied. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209 . . ."). However, because Respondent's designation of matter included pages 160 and 165-167, her request to add these pages to the record is granted. Finally, Respondent's request for an extension to file her final brief is granted. Appellant shall file an amended record within thirty days of the date of this order, and Respondent shall file her final brief within twenty days thereafter.

¹ Although Respondent did not request the addition of page 166 in her motion, this page was included as an attachment along with the other pages she cited.
