Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I am writing jointly on behalf of myself for the Appellants, and along with attorney Kathryn Williams, counsel for the Respondent, April Mauldin. Based on the most recent Order of the Court of Appeals, the time for the filing of the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter of the Appellants/Defendants would be July 25, 2014. I am writing to inform that the parties have reached a compromise settlement in principal. However, because this is a workers' compensation matter, and the Respondent is currently on Social Security Disability and Medicare eligible, a partial approval of certain materials terms to the settlement need to be approved by the Center for Medicare/Medicaid Services (CMMS). This process can take up to several weeks, but in the interest of judicial economy, we would jointly request that the time line for additional filings be stayed at this time in order for the compromise settlement in this matter to be reduced to writing, considered/approved by CMMS, and submitted to the S.C. Workers' Compensation Commission for approval, which would negate the need to go forward with the current appeal in this matter pending before the Court of Appeals as tracking number 2014-000722, and as referenced above.
