

ORDER

Petitioner seeks a third extension of time to serve and file the petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. By order dated July 16, 2014, this Court established a new policy for extensions of time in matters seeking review of a decision of the Court of Appeals. *In re Extensions in Cases Seeking a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to Review a Decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals*, Order of the S.C. Supreme Court dated July 16, 2014. The order states that parties who have already been granted an extension totaling twenty days or more prior to the date of the order may receive one additional ten day extension of time upon a showing of good cause and any further extensions will be granted only upon a showing of extraordinary circumstances. *Id.*

Petitioner has already received extensions of well over twenty days. We find she has not shown good cause for the additional ten day extension provided by this Court's order of July 16, 2014. Accordingly, petitioner's request for a third extension of time is denied and this matter is dismissed.
