## ORDER

On June 27, 2014, this Court reinstated this appeal, again denied the request to consolidate, and denied the request for disclosure of communications. The Court also ordered Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter to be served within thirty days. Appellant has now filed a request for rehearing by "full panell [sic] review" and a request for an extension. Pursuant to Rule 240(i) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, this Court declines to act on the request for rehearing because the order did not have the effect of dismissing or finally deciding Appellant's appeal. As to Appellant's request for an extension, Appellant shall serve and file Appellant's initial brief and designation of matter within twenty days.
