**MOTION TO EXCEED PAGE LIMITS  
FOR PETITION FOR  
WRIT OF CERTIORARI**

Respondent (“the State”), through its undersigned counsel, would respectfully show unto the Court as follows:

**I.**

The Petition for Writ of Certiorari is due to be served and filed on August 7, 2014.

**II.**

The State intends to raise three distinct issues in the Petition for Writ of Certiorari. Due to the fact-intensive nature of the issues being raised coupled with the length of the seven-hundred-five-page multi-volume Appendix, the State requests permission to exceed the twenty-five page limit permitted for a petition for writ of certiorari in order to enable the State to thoroughly and completely address the issues intended to be raised in the Petition for Writ of

Certiorari. See Rule 242(f), SCACR (“The total length of a return shall not exceed twenty-five (25) pages.”). The undersigned counsel believes no more than twenty-nine pages will be required to complete the Petition and asks this Court to permit the State to exceed the page limit for the Petition by four pages. The State further asserts this request will not result in any prejudice to Respondent.

**WHEREFORE**, the State prays that the Court allow the page limits for the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to be extended to twenty-nine pages; and for such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.


