MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Counsel respectfully requests a thirty day extension in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix is due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted

and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

On July 21, 2014, counsel filed a brief of petitioner and accompanying appendix in Martina R. Putnam v. State with the Court of Appeals. On July 9, 2014, counsel filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Robert Jenkins with the Court of Appeals. On July 2, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in State v. Ricky S. Bowman with this Court. On June 30, 2014, counsel filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Daniel Owens with the Court of Appeals. On June 27, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Donnell McFadden v. State with this Court. On June 13, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in George Jackson v. State with this Court. On June 11, 2014, counsel held an oral argument in State v. Shawn Antonio Miller before this Court. On June 5, 2014, counsel filed a brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Lavern Anderson with the Court of Appeals. On June 2, 2014, counsel filed a brief of appellant in State v. Jabbarie Brown with the Court of Appeals. On May 28, 2014, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Tony Moore. v. State with this Court.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload


