Dear Clerk:

I am in receipt of your letter dated July 29, 2014. In your letter you indicated that the transcript in my case has not been provided. I have not provided any transcript because my case was summarily dismissed without a formal hearing in the court below; therefore, no transcript exist. In addition, after my timely appeal, I provided the S.C. Supreme Court with an original and six (6) copies of my writ of Certiorari detailing my Jurisdictional Claim. The S.C. Supreme Court ultimately granted my Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis, issued me a docket number, and transferred my case to the S.C. Court of Appeals for a review of the merits of my Jurisdictional Claim and recusal motion.

Notwithstanding, it appears that the Court of Appeals is attempting to circumvent the S.C. Supreme Court's transfer of my case by requiring me to satisfy filing procedures contrary to the S.C. Appellate Court Rules. For example, (1) I originally filed a copy of my notice of appeal to Allen Wilson who was Respondent's Counsel of record in the Court of Common Pleas; however, the Court of Appeals directed me to refile a copy of my notice of appeal upon Sally Elliott who represented the Respondent after my appeal was filed, (2) the Supreme Court granted my "Motion to Proceed in Forma Pauperis" and issued me a case number (2014-000595); nevertheless, the Court of Appeals still required me to pay \$25.00 to file my motion and \$100 to file my case. Contrary to the S.C. Supreme Court's ruling; (3) I provided the Supreme Court with my original and six (6) copies of my "Petition for Writ of Certiorari" in which I denoted that no hearing was held on my case and that no transcript existed; nevertheless, the Court of Appeals has insisted that I must file a "Brief" on the same claims contained in my petition for writ of Certiorari, which I assumed was transferred to the Court of Appeals for review of my claims.

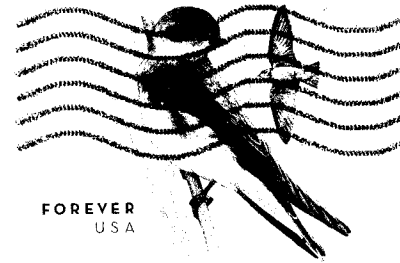
