## ORDER



Petitioner has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari seeking review of a conditional order of dismissal dated July 1, 2014. Since review in a post-conviction relief case is commenced by serving and filing a notice of appeal under Rule 243 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, this petition has been construed as a notice of appeal.

The notice of appeal is dismissed without prejudice because the order is not an appealable order. *Lewis v. State*, 368 S.C. 630, 630 S.E.2d 464 (2006). The motion to appoint counsel is denied as moot. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
