
Appellants hereby move for an order that permits the parties to this case to file less than the number of copies of the final brief and record on appeal in this case required by Rules 210 and 211, SCACR. The grounds for this motion are that there is good cause for such a reduction, as the following shows:

1. Rules 210 and 211, SCACR, require the filing of 15 bound copies each of the final brief and record on appeal.
2. Having the bound copies made is very expensive, with the cost for an appellant typically running at or near a thousand dollars to have such a number of copies made.
3. Given the advances in PDF technology and the court's use of the same, as well as the fact that almost all cases in this court are adjudged only by a three-judge panel, it seems that such a large number of briefs are not needed for the typical appeal and will probably not be used in this appeal.
4. The Appellants are people of modest means. After all, this is a real estate foreclosure case concerning their residence. Any lessening of the costs of this case is a help to them.
5. The Appellants suggest that the bound-copy filing requirements for the final briefs and record on appeal be reduced from 15 to three.
6. In the interest of fairness, this reduction should apply to the Respondent as well.
7. If a greater number of briefs or the record on appeal are desired later, the court could always require the parties to file additional copies.

8. Opposing counsel consents to the relief sought in this motion.

WHEREFORE Appellants pray for an order that permits the parties to this case to file less than the number of copies of the final brief and record on appeal in this case required by Rules 210 and 211, SCACR.




