
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME BY APPELLANT




Dear Honorable Kitchings:

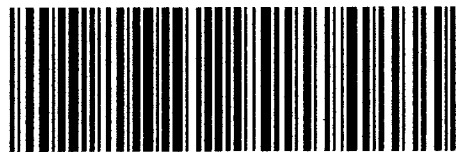
