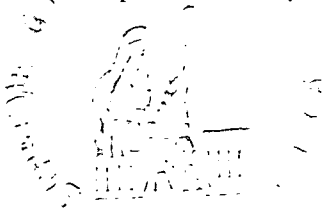
## ORDER


