
Dear Amy:

Please find attached a letter that we received from the South Carolina Supreme Court notifying us that the case of Margaree Maple v. Heritage Healthcare of Ridgeway has been set for hearing during the October term of the South Carolina Supreme Court held October 7, 8 and 9. I have several hearings scheduled in the above-referenced matters Clarence Winfrey, Gerald Rhynes and Kelly Mundy, and would request that these be rescheduled pursuant to the Circuit Court Rule. Also, I would note to you that in the cases of Rhynes and Mundy for rescheduling purposes of the Commissioners that I had been scheduled in Gerald Rhynes case for Hartsville on the same day that Kelly Mundy was scheduled in Columbia and would have needed to have one of those rescheduled in any event. Assuming that Ms. Maple's case is set for October 7th in the Supreme Court, I would appreciate it if I can have protection for the 6th also just to make sure that I have time to prepare for the oral argument.

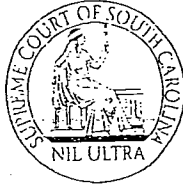
