Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I represent the Respondents in the above-referenced appeal. On behalf of the Respondents, on May 19, 2014, I filed a Motion to Challenge Appellant's Record on Appeal as Submitted. Specifically, Plaintiff's entire Record on Appeal did not comply with Rules 210 and 267 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, as the Record on Appeal submitted by the Appellant did not include all of the documents listed by the Respondents in their Designation of Matters to be Included on the Record on Appeal.

On June 23, 2014, the Court issued an Order on Respondents' Motion noting that the Record on Appeal did not contain a Certificate from Appellant as provided in Rule 210, SCACR, and that the Record on Appeal did not contain all matters designated by the Respondents. Furthermore, the Order stated that Appellant had 20 days to serve a Supplemental Record on Appeal correcting these deficiencies.

On July 3, 2014, we received Appellant's apparent "Supplemental Record on Appeal." In this document, the Appellant certified that the Record on Appeal contained all matters proposed to be included by the parties under Rules 210 and 267, SCACR. Additionally, Appellant alleged that he unintentionally did not include all matters designated by the Respondents in his Record on Appeal. However, Appellant simply attached a copy of the Respondents' Designation of Matters to be Included on the Record on Appeal, which was previously filed with this Court.


