At a Court of General Sessions, convened on July 14, 2014, the Grand Jurors of Aiken County present upon their oath:

That GREGORY CARROLL LANGDALE did in Aiken County on or about February 10, 2014, take possession, carry away, transfer to another area of the store; alter, transfer or remove the price label or tag; transfer from its container to another container; and/or wilfully conceal certain merchandise valued at less than Two Thousand Dollars, to wit: tools, displayed, held, stored or offered for sale by Lowes, located at 1220 Knox Avenue, North Augusta, South Carolina, a store or retail mercantile establishment with the intention of depriving the merchant of the possession, use or benefit of the merchandise without paying the full retail value. The Defendant having previously been twice convicted of offenses for which the term of imprisonment was contingent upon the value of the property involved. All in violation of §16-13-110 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976), as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.

I am financially unable to employ counsel and request that counsel be assigned to represent me. I understand that I am entitled to at least 30 days notice before a claim against me may be reduced to judgment, and I do hereby waive the right to such notice.
