**MOTION TO ENLARGE TIME FOR
FILING INITIAL BRIEF OF RESPONDENT AND
DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

The Respondent, above-named, by and through the undersigned attorneys, would respectfully move this Court for a 30-day extension of time within which to file its Initial Brief of Respondent. (G)State v. Kareem Harry (Initial Brief of Respondent) **filed in this Court on July 21, 2014;**

(J) State v. Marcus Wright (Murder) (Initial Brief of Respondent) **in process (13 issues raised);**

(K) Robert Laroche v. Warden (Federal Habeas Return) **filed on or about August 12, 2014;**

(L) Robert Laroche v. Warden (Federal Habeas case) **status report filed with U.S. Magistrate today, August 20, 2014;**

and, other matters.

2. Respondent has consulted with opposing counsel, David Alexander, and he does not object to the requested extension. This is a 2nd extension request.

For good cause shown, Respondent respectfully requests this Court grant an extension of thirty (30) days up to and including **September 19, 2014** in which to file the Initial Brief of Respondent.






