STATE VS. INMAN — S.C. — S.E. 2d (2014)
Opinion No. 27402, March 04, 2014

Did trial counsel properly object to the court allowing Juror 54 and Juror 83 to participate in defendant's trial. 1) Juror 54 goes to the same church as Daniel K. Swad; 2) Juror ~~83~~ 83 husband work with the Sheriff Department as a dispatcher. The state witness name is Daniel K. Swad; as both jurors are white's female.

CITE:

STATE VS. TAMM, opinion No. 27402, March 4, 2014 Supreme Court held that the circuit court in properly granted the states Batson motion after appellant offered a race-neutral explanation for striking a particular juror. The court use a three step analysis. First the [party asserting the Batson] challenge must make a prima facie showing that the challenge was based on race. Second, the explanation must only be clear and reasonably specific such that the [party asserting the Batson challenge] has a full and fair opportunity to demonstrate pretext in the reason given and the trial court to fulfill its duty [in step three] to assess the plausibility of the reason in light of all the evidence with a bearing on it. Third analysis requires the court to carefully evaluate whether the party asserting the Batson challenge has proven racial discrimination by demonstrating that the proffered race-neutral reason are mere pretext for a discriminatory intent.

The Appellant here by seek relief from this Court of Appeals after providing support documents and evidence of an illegal sentence and conviction and respectfully ask this court to vacated sentence.
