Greetings!

On a former day, the Court entered an Order, in the above captioned Case, to the effect that the Court would send the Remittitur, in this Case, to the Lower Court, on August 25, 2014, in the event that the Case had been Settled. However, please be advised that, although most of the Parties have reached a Settlement; nevertheless, as of this date, the Settlement Agreement has not been signed by the Parties. As such, as of this date, this Case is not Settled.

Also, although the Parties contemplate that the Settlement will be "private;" nevertheless, there is an aspect of the Settlement Agreement that will require the Court's approval. 
