
I am providing the following arguable information for my case.

1. *JBK Trucking Inc. purchased fuel from Homewood Depot on a bi-weekly basis, the owner Mr. V.J. required that he have a blank signed check or either a check made out for a certain amount. The checks were to be destroyed once he had received payment on the due date.*
2. *In December 3, 2012 my husband had surgery and my mechanic took Mr. V.J. payments, they were signed over checks from one of our contractors and cashiers checks made payable to Homewood Depot.*
3. *On December 21, 2012, I informed Mr. V.J. that we would not be purchasing fuel from him any longer, he had agreed to charge us the cash price but instead added the five cents per gallon for being put on charge card and he had ran out of fuel on several occasions. Mr. V. J. deposited the three checks that afternoon, knowing full well that the funds were not there, he even changed the date on one of the blank checks he should have*

destroyed months earlier. My attorney told me I should have got him for fraud, but that issue was never pursued.

4. We probably owe Homewood Depot something but nowhere in the amount of the \$10,472.97.
5. We provided copies of all payments made to the court at the restitution hearing but the Presiding Judge did not account for any of the payments made by JBK Trucking Inc. to Homewood Depot.
6. At the time of the hearing, my attorney would not allow any of this evidence to be presented, and I have since learned that my attorney is no longer with the Horry County Public Defenders Office.
7. I made some mistakes by leaving the blank checks or checks made out for a certain amount, but sometimes you do what you do things to keep operating. Another mistake I made was trusting M. V. J. to destroy the checks like he said he would.

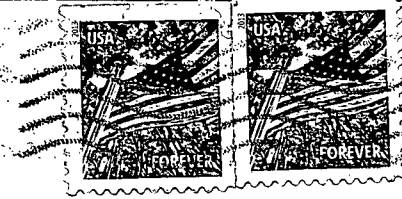
I am personally writing this appeal request, I do not know if I used the proper wording or not. I am thanking you in advance for your consideration on the above matter.
