**PETITION FOR EXTENSION TO FILE
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX**

The undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final** thirty-day extension in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the above-referenced case. In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following exigent circumstances:

Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Clarence Williams Jenkins in the Court of Appeals on July 24, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. David Gerrard Johnson with this Court on July 17, 2014. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter along with the Record on Appeal in the case of State v. Derrick Ladon Clark in the Court of Appeals on July 17, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Dantonyo Heath in the Court of Appeals on July 10, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Jeffrey Dodd Thomas, with this Court on July 10, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Kwaun Ka'Shawn Peay v. State in this Court on July 7, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Julia Gorman with this Court on July 7, 2014. Counsel filed the



4. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.


5. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


