INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on June 19, 2014, the Grand Jurors of York County present upon their oath:

DUI FELONY CAUSING DEATH

Anthony Lamar Ogden did on or about January 31, 2014, while driving a vehicle under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or a combination thereof, perform an act forbidden by law or neglect a duty imposed by law in the driving of the vehicle. The Defendant committed one or more of the following unlawful acts and/or neglected one or more of the following duties imposed by law while driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs causing the deadly wreck: failing to exercise due care, failing to maintain proper control of his vehicle, reckless driving, driving too fast for conditions and/or following too closely. The Defendant's unlawful act or neglect proximately caused the death of Alva Lee Terrell in violation of Section 56-5-2945, *Code of Laws of South Carolina* (1976), as amended. The crime occurred on SC Highway 21 south of Fort Mill in York County, South Carolina.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
