ORDER

Appellant's request to proceed *in forma pauperis* was denied on July 8, 2014. Appellant was ordered to pay the notice of appeal filing fee within fifteen days. Appellant has now filed several motions, which we construe together as a petition for rehearing from the denial of the *in forma pauperis* motion, a second *in forma pauperis* motion, a request for injunctive relief, and a request for a thirty-day extension to pay the notice of appeal filing fee. First, as to the request to rehear the denial of the *in forma pauperis* motion, this Court declines to entertain the petition. *See* Rule 240(i), SCACR ("The court will not entertain petitions for rehearing on a motion or petition unless the action of the court on the motion or petition has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal."). Second, Appellant's subsequent request to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied. Third, Appellant's request for injunctive relief is denied. Finally, Appellant shall have ten days to pay the notice of appeal filing fee. Failure to pay the filing fee within ten days will result in the dismissal of this appeal.
