



**Details of the Present Violation:**

W-42-13-436

Failing to notify the agent immediately upon arrest or questioning by law enforcement. The offender was arrested on 8-14-13 for False Information to Police and Trespassing After Notice. The offender failed to advise agent of the matter at the issuance of the warrant.

Failing to follow the advise and instructions of the agent. The offender was arrested and served with violation of probation warrant on 7-11-13. The offender was advised by the agent that he needed to report back to the agent if he made bond. The offender made bond on 7-23-13 and failed to report to the agent at the issuance of the warrant.

There is probable cause to believe that the offender was involved in a Murder that occurred in the city limits of Spartanburg, SC. The Spartanburg Police Department named the suspect responsible for assaulting a Curtis Goldsmith, which resulted in his death.

Failing to report as instructed. The offender missed his office progress report on 3-19-13.

Failing to notify the agent of change of address. The agent conducted a home visit at the offender's reported address of 189 N Forest St, Spartanburg, SC on 3-27-13. The agent was informed by management that the offender checked out of the facility on 2-24-13.

Failing to pay supervision fee by being \$50 in arrears at the issuance of the warrant.

Failing to pay fine by being \$40 in arrears at the issuance of the warrant.

Failing to drug test fee by being \$20 in arrears at the issuance of the warrant.

Failing to follow the advice and instructions of the agent

Special Conditions-The offender was ordered by the Court to complete substance abuse counseling. The agent referred the offender to SADAC on 2-28-13. Agent called SADAC on 3-27-13 and was advised that he never enrolled in program.

**Agent's Recommendation:**

Revocation.

**Agent's Justification:**

The previous seven of the eight cases the offender has had with the department, resulted in revocation. When the offender reported for intake the agent joking said that he needed to take a good look at the offender because based on his past, he would never report again. The offender never came back to the office after that first visit. The agent attempted to arrest the offender at Magolina St Apartments but he took off running and the agent lost site of him in Victoria Gardens Apartments. After the offender was arrested on the first violation warrant, he was instructed to report back to the office if he made bond. The agent noticed that offender was arrested again on 8-14-13 for False Information to Police and Trespassing After Notice. Later that same day, the offender was implicated in an assault that resulted in Curtis Goldsmith's death.
