
At a Court of General Sessions, convened on May 27, 2010, the Grand Jurors of Horry County present upon their oath:

**HOMICIDE BY CHILD ABUSE**  
**Aiding and/or Abetting**  
**CDR: 2357 16-03-0085(A)(2)**

That Robert Andrew Palmer did in Horry County, from on or about July 14, 2008, through July 16, 2008, knowingly aid and abet another to commit child abuse and neglect upon Victim (MINOR), a seventeen (17) month old child, resulting in his suffering severe fatal injuries and death as a result of those injuries, his subsequent death declared on July 16, 2008. in violation of Section 16-03-0085(A)(2), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.




