In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following extraordinary circumstances:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel is filing the brief of petitioner in the case of Antwan McMilan v. State and the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Milo Tudor v. State in this Court today, September 8, 2014. Counsel filed the return to the petition for rehearing



Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Zachary Bullock in the Court of Appeals on August 6, 2014. Counsel filed the brief of respondent in the case of Shanna Kranchick v. State of South Carolina in the Court of Appeals on July 18, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Cesar Portillo v. State with this Court on July 18, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Ted Abney v. State with this Court on July 18, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Frankie Lee McGee v. State with this Court on July 18, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Monica Lasondra Yazid v. State with this Court on July 17, 2014.


3. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state does not oppose this request.

4. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty day extension, until October 8, 2014**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


