ORDER

In *Ex parte Harrell*, 409 S.C. 60, 760 S.E.2d 808 (2014), this Court reversed and remanded this case. On remand, a consent order was issued by the circuit court. The judge indicated that any decision to make the consent order public would have to be made by this Court.
