At a Court of General Sessions, convened on November 14, 2013 the Grand Jurors of SUMTER County present upon their oath:

COUNT ONE

ATTEMPTED MURDER

That Trevaughn Ziontae Jackson, in Sumter on or about August 31, 2013, violate Section 16-3-29 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976), as amended, in that the said Trevaughn Ziontae Jackson did with intent to kill, attempt to kill another person, Frank Cokley, with malice aforethought, either express or implied, by shooting one Frank Dwayne Cokley with a handgun at 1046 Dilbert Street, Sumter, South Carolina.

COUNT TWO

ATTEMPTED MURDER

That Trevaughn Ziontae Jackson did in Sumter on or about August 31, 2013, violate Section 16-3-29 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976), as amended, in that the said Trevaughn Ziontae Jackson did with intent to kill, attempt to kill another person, Frank Cokley, with malice aforethought, either express or implied, by shooting one Sylvia Ann Welch with a handgun at 1046 Dilbert Street, Sumter, South Carolina.

COUNT THREE

POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING THE COMMISSION OF A VIOLENT CRIME

That Trevaughn Ziontae Jackson did in Sumter County, on or about August 31, 2013, possess a firearm, or visibly display what appeared to be a firearm during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime, in violation of Section 16-23-0490, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT FOUR

UNLAWFUL CARRYING OF A PISTOL

That Trevaughn Ziontae Jackson did in Sumter County on or about August 31, 2013, carry about the person a pistol, such carrying not being authorized by law, in violation of Section 16-23-0020, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT FIVE

DISCHARGING FIREARM INTO DWELLING

That Trevaughn Ziontae Jackson did in Sumter County on or about August 31, 2013, discharge or cause to be discharged unlawfully, firearms at or into a dwelling house or other building or enclosure regularly occupied by persons; while it was occupied, in violation of Section 16-23-0440, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.




