This letter is in response to Rule 207(a)(1) which requires the Appellant to "contemporaneously furnish all counsel of record, the Office of Court Administration, and the Clerk of the Appellate Court with copies of all correspondence with the Court Reporter."

The Foreclosure Hearing for this Case was conducted on May 19, 2014. After ruling on several Motions, the Court issued a Final Order, which was received on June 15, 2014. The Appellants' Notice of Appeal was served on July 2, 2014.

The last correspondence between my office and the Reporter was transmittal of payment. (A copy of my 8/27/2014 letter is enclosed).

This Case is now in the "Initial Brief of Appellants" preparation stage. The attendant 30 days started on August 25, 2014.
