Dear Mr. Haynes:

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR, specifically the Respondent's counsel name.
- Our records reflect that the time for ordering the transcript has expired, you must file a copy of the letter showing that you have ordered the transcript directly from the court reporter.

- Your motion for an extension will be reviewed after the order is received. When sending the circuit court order, advise when you received written notice of entry of the order.
