MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

TO: ALL PARTIES AND THE SUPREME COURT:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Petitioners hereby move the Supreme Court for an Order extending their time for filing their Brief on Writ of Certiorari. The Brief is currently due September 22, 2014, and the Petitioners request an extension of thirty (30) days, until October 22, 2014. The basis of this motion is as follows:


Lead counsel for Petitioners runs a small firm with three attorneys. One of the attorneys, Michael Corley, left the practice on September 6, 2014, to move Upstate and closer to family since

the birth of his first child. Counsel has been reviewing applications and conducting interviews with potential new attorneys for the past several weeks, and will be continuing the interview process for at least two more weeks. Aside from the time that counsel has had to spend conducting the hiring process, she is also assuming responsibility as lead counsel on all of Mr. Corley's cases. One of those cases is scheduled for trial November 3 – 7.

In addition, counsel has a day-certain trial before Special Referee, Thomas J. Wills, September 15 – 17. Counsel has been preparing and will be continuing to prepare for trial during the first two weeks of September. Due to these competing obligations and responsibilities counsel will not have adequate time to complete the Petitioners' Brief by September 22, 2014.

Counsel for Petitioners has consulted with counsel for both Respondents and has been informed that both Respondent DHEC and Respondent Roper Pond, LLC consent to this requested extension.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioners request that the Supreme Court enter an order extending the time for filing their Reply in support of Petition for a Writ of Certiorari until October 22, 2014.


