
PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

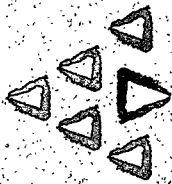
