PETITION TO FILE
SUPPLEMENTAL APPENDIX

Pursuant to Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the undersigned counsel requests leave in which to file copies of a supplemental appendix in the case. In support of this motion, counsel submits the following facts.

1. Petitioner Louis Sheppard was convicted of assault and battery with intent to kill per jury trial held during the July 2007 term of the Dorchester County General Sessions Court before Judge Diane S. Goodstein. Petitioner was sentenced to imprisonment for a period of life without parole pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. 17-25-45. Petitioner appealed, but after briefing the case was dismissed by the South Carolina Supreme Court. State v. Sheppard, Op. No. 2010-UP-118 (2010).

On July 26, 2010, petitioner filed a PCR application with the Dorchester County Office of the Clerk of Court and an amended PCR application with the Clerk on March 11, 2011. The

respondent filed a return dated February 4, 2011, requesting that a hearing be held in response to petitioner's PCR action.


A PCR hearing was convened on August 30, 2011, at the Dorchester County Courthouse before Judge Edgar H. Dickson. On November 1, 2013, Judge Dickson issued an Order of Dismissal in the case denying relief to petitioner. Petitioner appealed Judge Dickson's Order.

2. A petition for writ of certiorari and appendix were filed with the Court on May 8, 2014. However, it has come to my attention recently that certain pages are missing from the trial transcript in the case.

3. Inasmuch as these papers are relevant to the appeal and per Rule 243(f)(1), SCACR, are required to be included in the appendix, counsel requests leave in which to include the same in supplemental appendices. Note by the signature below that opposing counsel consents to the filing of the copies of the supplemental appendix in the case.

WHEREFORE, counsel requests leave in which to file copies of a supplemental appendix in the case.




