

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Kelvin Mays v. State with this Court on August 21, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jesse Ray Lane v. State with this Court on August 18, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Deshawn Powell in the Court of Appeals on August 14, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Zachary Bullock in the Court of Appeals on August 6, 2014.

3. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state does not oppose this request.




