

Your Honor

My name is Wanda M Shearer and I was present on November 17 2011 at the Jackson v Denno Hearing for Matthew Brandon Fullbright. It has come to my attention that this court in which you presided is failing and has failed to acknowledge that Matthew took the stand and gave oral testimony in this hearing.

I clearly remember him giving testimony and have sent Matthew and his father and the courts of appeal in which Susan Hackett is representing Matthew at appellate attorney copies of my sworn affidavit in which he did so testify. I have also provided Matthew and his father, all available media pictures in which there is obvious movement within the court showing Matthew in motion, papers in hand, etc.

I have in my possession the court reporters timeline and transcript in which there appears to be a 10 minutes or so missing from her record and the transcript. I clearly remember after his father (Marshall) gave testimony that Matthew took the stand and was asked questions concerning his alleged signatures. I also remember a statement you made to Matthew while on the stand. Verbatim statement you made I cannot give, but Matthew wanted to ask if his lawyer would be asking him about the signatures in question and your statement was in the response of, "Son, you are not up here to ask questions, you are to answer what is asked". Again maybe not verbatim, but along those lines was the conversation. So even as a layperson, that statement could not have been made unless Matthew was on the stand.

I have had a person contact me who was also in the courtroom that day who has a recorded type media in which clearly agrees with my affidavit that Matthew gave testimony. This has not been divulged to the court that a recording was made that day in court without the courts knowledge. I have been assured as Matthews' father, myself, and Matthew will have that recording in our hands as his appeals process is ongoing.

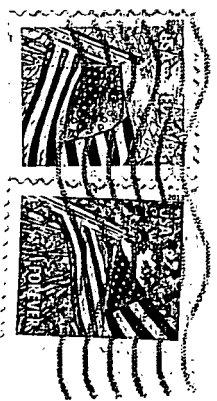
