


ORDER

This matter is before the Court on a petition for a writ of certiorari. The petition for a writ of certiorari is granted and we dispense with further briefing.


This Court further directs Judge Roger Young to order the South Carolina Department of Corrections to deliver petitioner to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons to begin serving his federal sentence.

Upon release from state prison and transfer to a federal penitentiary, petitioner may attempt to gain credit for the time served on his state sentence through the Bureau of Prisons which must designate the state prison a federal facility *nunc pro tunc*. *Barden v. Keohane*, 921 F.2d 476 (3d Cir. 1990).
