Pursuant to Rule 245 of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedures, the Petitioner requests an Emergency Petition for Writ for Extraordinary Relief. The Petitioner request that the Court issue a Temporary Injunction, Restraining Order against the Respondent and Taylor Concrete and Finishing, the Respondent's business until such time that a ruling can be rendered upon the matter on appeal. Further, the Petitioner request permission to proceed with a Petition for Original Jurisdiction to aid in consideration of the matter on appeal. Pursuant to S.C. Code of Law § 15-53-10 through § 15-53-140, the Petitioner desires to seek a declaratory action judgment against the Respondent's claim to a prescriptive easement by prescription for ingress and egress over the roadway at 3400 Highway 261 North.

The Petitioner hereby request such emergency relief as the Respondent refuses to abide with guidance given by the lower court to have no contact with the Petitioner, or her residence.

The Petitioner believes the lengthy legal process to redress violations of her civil rights under South Carolina Human Affairs Law has unfairly rewarded and empowered the Respondent to continue intrusive and aggressive acts that threatens the Petitioner's physical, emotional and mental well-being.

Finally, the Petitioner urges the Court to act granting the relief sought in the interest of public safety and to deescalate conflict. The Sumter County Sheriff's Department is not vested with the authority to interpret a claim for easement nor holds authority to issue a de facto declaratory action judgment on the Respondent's

behalf.

Wherefore, the Petitioner prayerfully request
such relief.
