Dear Mr. Shearouse:

I am writing regarding Mr. Salter's recent motion to require me to file a supplemental appendix in this matter. As Mr. Salter stated in his motion, he contacted me and asked me to file a supplemental appendix containing Applicant's PCR Exhibit 15, which was not originally included in the appendix. I told Mr. Salter that I had no problem with his request, and that I would get back to him. Exhibit 15 is a large document comprised of numerous social history records. My paralegal and I determined that we did not have a complete copy of this exhibit on hand, so we requested it from the county clerk.
