To: Whom it may concern,

We, the Walthour Family, are the children of the late Mrs. Nazarene Marie Wright Walthour. Mrs. Nazarene Marie Wright Walthour was the only child of the late Mr. William Henry "Boy" Wright, who was our maternal grandfather. Accordingly, we wish to inform you of our wishes concerning the handling of the "John Giles Estate".

We wish to make it clear, with no uncertain terms that we do not want or agree to the sale of the one fifth share or whatever portion by rightful inheritance of the above referenced property under any conditions or circumstances or on any grounds.

It would be a disgrace and a dishonor to our mother and our grandparents to turn our backs on our birthright. We can only imagine what our great grandparents and our grandfather must have suffered and sacrificed to acquire and to keep this property. Subsequently, we say "No" to the sale of our share of this property. We cannot accept the terms that you have suggested.

We request that this case be re-opened, thus allowing us, the Walthour children---direct descendants of Mr. William Henry "Boy" Wright(our grandfather) and Mrs. Nazarene Marie Wright Walthour(our mother)--- to cut out our share and leave the remaining four fifths or whatever portion by rightful inheritance for the others to do as they please with their share.

Appallingly, we were not notified and given the opportunity to exercise our rights in making any decision regarding this property. Moreover, our due process rights were violated, in addition to other legal infractions.

We contest your decision and request that the case be re-opened.
