

ORDER

On May 7, 2014, June 3, 2014, and June 19, 2014, this court sent letters to Appellant explaining it is Appellant's responsibility to order the transcript from the court reporter and to make satisfactory arrangements for the payment of the transcript. *See* Rule 207, SCACR. On August 6, 2014, this court issued an order requiring Appellant, within fifteen days, to serve and file a motion to order the transcript late, prove the transcript has been ordered from the correct court reporter, and prove satisfactory arrangements for the payment of the transcript have been made. Although Appellant filed a letter on August 25, 2014, that we construe as a motion to order the transcript late, Appellant failed to serve and file proof the transcript has been ordered from the correct court reporter or proof satisfactory arrangements for the payment of the transcript have been made. Accordingly, Appellant's appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
