

ORDER

Respondent has filed a motion to exceed the page limit for its initial brief as set forth in Rule 208(b)(5) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules and seeks to file a brief ninety-four pages in length. After careful review of the parties' filings, we find the issues raised on appeal do not demand a brief of this length. However, Respondent may file an amended brief totaling no more than sixty-five pages in length. Respondent has thirty days to serve and file the amended brief, and Appellant's reply brief shall be due ten days thereafter.
