In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following extraordinary circumstances:

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Kelvin Mays v. State with the Supreme Court on August 21, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jesse Ray Lane v. State with the Supreme Court on August 18, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Deshawn Powell in this Court on August 14, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Zachary Bullock in this Court on August 6, 2014.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.




