ORDER

On September 12, 2014, Appellant Beverley D. Wilson filed a letter addressed to this Court along with fifteen copies of letters addressed to the Attorney General of the United States. Appellant also filed a motion on July 18, 2014, asking the Court to amend her designation of matter and remove her letters to the Attorney General because they were not presented to the circuit court. Appellant's motion is granted. Appellant may not include the letters to the Attorney General in her record on appeal pursuant to Rule 201(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR) ("The Record shall not, however, include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal."). Accordingly, the documents filed along with Appellant's September 12, 2014 letter shall be returned and will not be considered by the Court.
