

## ORDER

Petitioner has filed a motion entitled "Motion for Enforcement of Rights." To the extent that this motion may be seeking to compel his appellate counsel to raise all arguable issues in the petition for a writ of certiorari, the motion is denied. *Jones v. State*, 348 S.C. 13, 558 S.E.2d 517 (2002) ("At the appellate stage, particularly, succinct, relevant legal arguments are most likely to be persuasive. Counsel is best able to use professional judgment to determine which arguments are relevant and should be presented for appellate review.").
