MOTION TO FORGIVE ERROR,
AND ALLOW APPELLANT TO
PREPARE BRIEF.

There is simply no other way to say it, I offer no excuses - I, the Appellant in the above captioned case, messed up and missed the time to have my initial brief before this court.

I pray from this Court enough time to prepare and file the brief. The Appellant has spent the last two weeks attempting to, to look for and figure out what to do about the Court not acknowledging the receipt of this Appellant's \$100.⁰⁰ filing fee. It is completely Appellant's fault for misunderstanding some of the SCACR, even though he has been diligent in trying. Appellant admits, they are deceptively simple, and if this Court graciously allows Appellant to continue, Appellant will try hard to get it right.

Appellant is attempting to perfect, in this Court, an appeal taken from the Administrative Law Court ("ALC") involving the seizure of, and redaction, editing, copying, etc. of Appellant's privileged attorney-client privileged communication, Rule 5 discovery, attorney work product and more from criminal charges, Anderson County,

by the S.C. Department of Corrections ("SCDC") on August 19, 2013, when it arrived here at Lieber Correctional Institution ("LCI").

* This, actually, after that, is where Appellant erred; Appellant awaited This Court, or The Clerk to reply to Appellant in receipt of the documents and \$100.⁰⁰

On August 27, 2014, I the Appellant sent a 1 page letter, accompanied by an affidavit, and a proof of service to The Clerk of Court. The affidavit touched on the fact that I submitted the needed documents and the \$100.⁰⁰ Filing Fee, and that if the Court had in fact received everything.



Dear Clerk:


