
**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE**

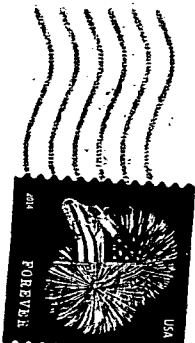
