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## ORDER

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Respondent has filed a motion to supplement the Record on Appeal and to amend its designation of matter to include an inadvertent omission entitled "correspondence dated December 28, 2006, and December 29, 2006." Respondent indicated this matter was referenced in its initial brief but inadvertently omitted from the designation of matter. No return was filed. Accordingly, Respondent's motion is granted. Within ten days, excluding the filing date of this order, Respondent shall serve and file a supplemental Record on Appeal containing the omitted matter.

Respondent also filed a motion to strike pages 319-328 from the supplemental Record on Appeal, stating the pages were labeled "Segars Notice of Intent to Appeal"; however, they actually contained a preliminary tax appeal statement that is not properly before this Court. No return was filed. Accordingly, Respondent's motion to strike is granted. Within ten days, excluding the filing date of this order, Appellants shall serve and file a second supplemental Record on Appeal, omitting the stricken matters.

Appellants filed a motion for a sixty-day continuance, stating Appellants recently retained Mr. Gregory Michael Galvin, and Mr. Galvin needs "ample opportunity" to research and draft a brief. Because initial briefs and the Record on Appeal have already been filed in this case, Appellant's motion for a sixty-day continuance is denied.
