The Court has received your correspondence dated September 12, 2014 and September 18, 2014. Please be advised that if you wish this Court to waive fees, a motion to proceed in forma pauperis must be served and filed within ten (10) days from the date of this letter. The motion to proceed in forma pauperis must meet the requirements of Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR).

On September 8, 2014, the Court sent a deficiency letter requesting a notice of appeal containing all information required by Rule 203, SCACR, a proof of service naming the documents served on all parties, and a copy of the order being challenged on appeal. These documents have not been received by the Court. Within ten (10) days of the date of this letter, you must correct the deficiencies. Your appeal will be dismissed if these deficiencies are not cured within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
