TO: THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA
COURT OF APPEALS:

COMES NOW the Respondent Charleston County School District, by and through its undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and moves this Honorable Court for a thirty (30) day extension of time to serve and file its initial brief and corresponding designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

The Appellant served her initial brief on August 7, 2014; thereby, making the Respondent's initial briefing deadline September 8, 2014, according to Rule 208(a)(2), SCACR. Previously, via letter request, the Respondent sought a 30-day extension of its briefing deadline, which the Court granted by order filed September 10, 2014, extending such deadline through October 8, 2014.

Further, Respondent respectfully requests that the Court hold Respondent's present deadline for briefing/designation of matter in abeyance until it acts upon this motion.
