

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Javon Rivers v. State with the Supreme Court on September 10, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Julio Hunsburger in this Court on September 9, 2014. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Antwan McMilan v. State and the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Milo Tudor v. State in the Supreme Court on September 8, 2014. Counsel filed the return to the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Michael Wilson Pearson with this Court on August 29, 2014.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

4. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


