
Second Letter re inclusion of the Document: Initial Reply Brief (IRB): Thinking that this document should be included for the benefit of the Court or the Respondent I assumed that it would be appropriate to include the IRB. Therefore, I wrote the letter on August 28, 2014 requesting same from the Court and the Respondent. I waited for a response but received none before I had to proceed with mailing the Final Brief of Appellant (FBA), and bound copies of the ROA. I actually received your letter AFTER I had already mailed the FRB and ROA – bound copies! The IRB is NOT listed in the Index of Record on Appeal, AND is NOT referred to in the FBA, however, somehow I did not remove it from the documents given to the printer. This IRB appears in the bound copies as the last eight (8) pages R. pp. 366-373.

I do not need to necessarily include those last 8 pages, but since they are NOT listed in the index and NOT referred to in the FBA, it seems to be a mute point that they are included in that they are never referenced. If there is something I need to further do re this, such as come to Columbia and tear-out the last 8 pages in each bound copy, please advise, otherwise just leave them as redundant pages.

I sincerely apologize for this inconvenience and confusion wherein I was apparently over-thinking the situation, and then after getting no reply I proceeded without removing those 8 pages.


